The homeless program does not provide food.</p>
Additional Notes	<p>GHS has several programs that serve a range of clientele.</p> <p>CRC is housing and reentry services on contract with DOC, the client must be under their jurisdiction.</p> <p>Juno House is transitional housing up to 18 months for homeless or endanger of homelessness - justice involvement is not necessary for services.</p> <p>Residential SUD Program is residential treatment by referral with 3.1 ASAM level of care (step down from Rainforest Recovery).</p> <p>Outpatients services include assessments, treatment planning, individual and group counseling, case management, etc.</p>
